User Guide

Overview

As you use your computer system, number of unwanted Apps, large files that are no more needed, old files, cache files downloaded while internet surfing, widgets, plug-ins, and many more keep growing inside the hard drive. These files eat up your valuable drive space, and hamper system speed and performance.

SpeedUp Mac can efficiently remove all unwanted applications and files from your Mac system. Large sized old files, duplicate files, universal binaries, cache files, etc. are effectively deleted releasing drive space. The application can also work as an Uninstaller that removes all avoidable applications, widgets and plug-ins from the system. In addition, **SpeedUp Mac** enables its users to backup files as zip files before removing them from the hard drive. You can also remove login items through this application. SpeedUp Mac is a complete booster for your Mac system.



Main User Interface

Why SpeedUp Mac?

Enhances Mac System Performance

Removing unwanted files from system boot Volume provides free space and increases performance.

SpeedUp Now *feature of SpeedUp Mac helps you to recover drive space by deleting unused large files, duplicate files, unusable part of universal binaries, and many more.*

Generates Free Space in Boot and other volumes

SpeedUp Mac allows you to select a volume and delete unnecessary files from them. In a Mac with a single volume, the boot volume is automatically selected and you can remove the unnecessary files from it and in multiple volume Mac, Custom Scan (Other Volumes) option shows all the other volumes including attached external storage devices, if any. Removal of unwanted files will generate free space in the volumes.

Uninstalls Applications

Uninstaller allows you to uninstall unused applications by drag and drop method. You need to drag the application into the **Uninstalled Dragged App** area which creates a tree of the application showing all the supported files. You can access the **Uninstaller** icon on the screen.

Removes Widgets

Widgets take up lot of space eventually slowing down system performance. Some widgets keep on running even when you're not using your dashboard. So it's always better to keep your widgets cut down to only what you're actually using. Uninstaller in **SpeedUp Mac** lists all the downloaded widgets and helps you to easily get rid of the unnecessary widgets.

Uninstalls Plugins

Plug-ins are a set of software components that adds specific capabilities to a larger software application. These add-ons may be automatically downloaded without your knowledge and take up drive space. Removing plugins will provide free space. So it is advisable to delete plug-ins. Uninstaller scans entire drive and list out all plug-ins, thus enabling you to delete the unwanted ones.

Removes Login Items

When you login to your computer, few items start automatically. **SpeedUp Mac** enables users to remove login items thereby decreasing booting time and enhancing the performance of your Mac.

Personalized Preferences

Preferences can be set for **SpeedUp Now** feature of the application. The set preferences are checked at the time the application starts execution and the tasks are performed according to the set preferences.

What is New in This Version?

SpeedUp Mac has the following new features:

• Find duplicate files for iTunes, iWork, iPhoto, Aperture and iMovie.

In addition to previous features mentioned below:

- Option to remove login items.
- Two new scan options Quick and Strict scans, added to Duplicate Files module.
- Two new scan options Recommended Scan for boot (single) volume and Custom Scan (multiple) for non bootable volumes.
- Removes system junk and unwanted files quickly.
- Generates free space in drive volumes by removing unnecessary files and applications.
- Enhances hard drive performance.
- Uninstall application by using drag and drop feature.
- Preview of drive scan result through Quick Look Section.
- Tasks can be scheduled to execute at a preset time.
- Attractive and user-friendly graphical interface.
- Allows setting up of preferences for SpeedUp Now Mathematications.

Installation Procedure

Before installing the software, ensure that your system meets minimum system requirements.

Minimum System Requirements

- Operating System: Snow Leopard 10.6 up to Mavericks 10.9 and above
- Memory: 1 GB RAM
- Hard Disk: 55 MB of free space

Steps to install SpeedUp Mac

To install SpeedUp Mac, follow these steps

Unpack SpeedUpMac.dmg.zip file.

- Decompressing the zip file and double click the dmg file. This step will mount a virtual volume SpeedUpMac.
- Double-click **SpeedUpMac** volume to open **SpeedUp Mac** application window.
- Drag SpeedUp Mac file to the Applications folder.
- To launch the software, double click on **SpeedUp Mac** file in **Applications** folder.
- This displays License Agreement. If user accepts the License Agreement, then the software is launched otherwise, it terminates.

To remove the software, drag and drop the **SpeedUpMac** file from **Applications** folder to **Trash**.

Order and Activate

Once the order is confirmed, a pre-paid registration key will be sent through e-mail, which would be required to register the software.

Register SpeedUp Mac

To Register SpeedUp Mac

- 1. On the **Tools** menu, click **Register**. *Registration* window is displayed.
- 2. Do one of the following:
 - If you have purchased the product and received registration key,
 - a. Select 'I have a key to register the product option. Click OK.
 - b. In the Registration Key box, type the key. Click **OK**.
 - If you have to purchase the product,
 - Select 'I don't have a key to register the product'. Click **OK**, to purchase the product.

Alternatively, when you try to remove any Large, Duplicate, Universal Binaries etc., or uninstall any applications, widgets or plug-ins using the demo version, *SpeedUp Mac Registration* window is displayed. Follow **Step 2** mentioned above to register.

How to Update?

Update feature available in **SpeedUp Mac** allows you to check and install the latest updates for the application. This will help you to keep your application up-to-date. If updates are available for the product, update wizard pops up while you run SpeedUp Mac. Otherwise, you can use **Updates** under **Preferences -> Scheduler** on the **SpeedUp Mac** menu.

To update SpeedUp Mac, do one of the following:

• To check automatically:

- 1. Run SpeedUp Mac, Update screen is displayed along with the main user interface.
- 2. To download the latest version, click **Update** button. It may take few seconds to minutes to download the files. Once completed, '*Update successfully installed*' message appears.
- 3. Click **OK**. Click **Cancel** to check for updates manually.

• To check manully:

- 1. Run SpeedUp Mac.
- 2. On the SpeedUp Mac menu, click Preferences option.
- 3. Click Scheduler tab in the Preferences screen. Click Check for updates now option.
- 4. If updates are available, Update screen is displayed. Follow the next step. Else, if no updates are available, a message that '*No updates are available*' is displayed.
- Click Update button to download the latest version. It may take few seconds to minutes to download the files. After completion, 'Update successfully installed' message appears. Click OK.

After latest updates are installed, restart SpeedUp Mac application.



Update feature is available only after you purchase and register the software.

Starting SpeedUp Mac

Follow any of the following methods to run SpeedUp Mac on a Mac system.

- Double click on **SpeedUp Mac** file in **Applications** folder.
- Double-click on **SpeedUp Mac** desktop shortcut (if it is created).

Devices

This tab is located on the Preferences screen of **SpeedUp Mac**. Click it to set rules for cleaning trashes and junk files in attached external storage devices.

Scheduler

This tab is located on the Preferences screen of **SpeedUp Mac**. Click it to schedule update and automatic launch scanning activity.

Ignore List

This tab is located on the Preferences screen of **SpeedUp Mac**. Click it to check applications whose files will not be scanned by **SpeedUp Mac**.

General

This tab is located on the Preferences screen of **SpeedUp Mac**. Click it to select files that will be searched while scanning for SpeedUp Now operation.

Folder Search

This tab is located on the Preferences screen of **SpeedUp Mac**. Click it to define the folder that will be scanned for Universal Binaries and language resources files during SpeedUp Now operation.

Languages

This tab is located on the Preferences screen of **SpeedUp Mac**. Click it to select the languages. Files of the selected languages will be searched. You can also set style in which scan results will be shown.

Files

This tab is located on the Preferences screen of **SpeedUp Mac**. Click it to set filter rules according to file type, size and access date constraints.

Advanced

This tab is located on the Preferences screen of **SpeedUp Mac**. Click it to set advanced options for sound, uninstaller and trash monitor.

SpeedUp Now for Single Volume Mac

You can use **SpeedUp Now** feature on a single volume Mac to find and remove unnecessary old large files, duplicate files, universal binaries, cache files, language files etc. from boot drive to improve performance.

To perform a complete scan and remove unwanted files/system junks:

- 1. Run **SpeedUp Mac**.
- 2. On the main screen, click **SpeedUp Now** icon.
- 3. Set Preferences for **SpeedUp Now**. Click **OK** to confirm. If **Preferences** are not set, scanning will be performed on the basis of previously set preferences.
- A scan is performed for all the Large files, Duplicate files, Universal Binaries, Cache files, Trashes and Left Overs, Language files, Log files, etc. according to the settings done in Preferences.

- 5. Scan result will show all the specified files, their file size and a **Finder** option that can be used to open a file. You can use the checkbox to select/unselect files. Scan result also provides information about how much drive space will be freed on deleting the files.
- 6. A message box with **Show Scan Result** and **SpeedUp Now** button is displayed.

- 7. Click **Show Scan Result** to view the result or Click **SpeedUp Now** button to remove the unwanted scanned files. You get a warning message for backing up important data. Select the required options.
- 8. Click **Proceed** button to start deleting the selected files.

You can **Stop** The application anytime and change the **Preference** settings. Use **Rescan** option to run the application with changed preferences.



Delete and create Zip archive of selected files at specified destination and Create alias of all selected files at source location options are available for large files.



Create alias of all selected files at source location options are available for duplicate files.

SpeedUp Now for Multiple Volume Mac

You can use **SpeedUp Now** feature for a multiple volume Mac to delete unnecessary cache files, large files, duplicate files, universal binaries, language files etc. **SpeedUp Mac** provides an option to quickly find and delete the unwanted files from bootable (Recommended Scan) as well as non bootable (Custom Scan) volumes, freeing up memory space.

To perform a scan on a volume and remove unwanted files from it, follow the steps given below:

- 1. Run SpeedUp Mac.
- 2. On the main screen, click **SpeedUp Now** icon.
- On select volume screen there are two scanning options, Recommended Scan (for scanning bootable volume) and Custom Scan (for scanning non bootable / other volumes). Opt for any one of the scanning options.
 - If you opt for **Recommended Scan** (which is selected by default), only the boot volume will be enabled from the list of volumes in the **Select Source Volume** pane.

Or, in case you opt for Custom Scan, all the non boot volumes will be enabled from the list of volumes in the Select Source Volume pane and you need to select any one volume from it. You can also select a volume from the volume drop-down list.

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Custom Scan screen

- 4. Click Start Scan button.
- A scan is performed for all the Large files, Duplicate files, Universal Binaries and Language files according to the settings done in **Preferences**.
- 6. Scan result will show all the specified files, their file size and a **Finder** option that can be used to open a file. You can use the checkbox to select/unselect files. Scan result also provides information about how much drive space will be freed on deleting the files.
- 7. A message box with Show Scan Result and SpeedUp Now button is displayed.
- 8. Click **Show Scan Result** to view the result or Click **SpeedUp Now** button to remove the unwanted scanned files. You get a warning message for backing up important data. Select the required options.
- 9. Click **Proceed** button to start deleting the selected files.

You can **Stop** the application anytime and change the **Preference** settings. Use **Rescan** preferences.



Delete and create Zip archive of selected files at specified destination and Create alias of all selected files at source location options are available only for large files.



Create alias of all selected files at source location options are available for duplicate files.

Remove Login Items

When you login to your computer, few items are started automatically. **SpeedUp Mac** enables you to remove login items and hence decrease booting time. This enhances the performance of your Mac. To remove login items:

- 1. Run SpeedUp Mac.
- 2. On the main screen, click **SpeedUp Now** icon.
- 3. Click Login Items icon visible on the toolbar.
- 4. Select the corresponding checkbox from the list of login items displayed in the **Remove Login Items** screen.

Uninstall using Uninstaller

- Uninstall Dragged App
- Applications
- Widgets
- Plug-ins

Uninstall Dragged App

You can uninstall your applications by using the Uninstalled Dragged App feature of the application. You need to just drag and drop any application/App, folder (containing an App) or a volume in the application area. All the applications in the dropped folder can be uninstalled.

To uninstall an application:

- 1. Run SpeedUp Mac.
- 2. On the main screen, click **SpeedUp Now** icon.
- 3. Now the **Uninstaller** icon is present on all the screens.
- 4. Click **Uninstaller**. You can see four tabs in the right pane. By default, **Uninstall Dragged App** tab is selected.
- You need to drag the application from anywhere in the system and drop to the Uninstall Dragged App area. As soon as you drop the application, SpeedUp Mac starts scanning for the application and its supported files.
- 6. After scan, the result shows the application and all files related to it.
- 7. Select the files which you want to uninstall or click **Select All/Unselect All** button to check/uncheck all the searched files. A warning message is displayed.
- 8. Check the desired files and click Uninstall Now.
- 9. Click OK button. "Uninstallation Complete" message is displayed.



In addition, you can drag and drop volumes to the uninstaller area. Entire volume is scanned and all the applications in it appear in tree form. You can select the desire application and uninstall it from the volume freeing up volume space.



If you want to exit the uninstaller section, click on **Close** Sutton.

Applications

Applications option of **SpeedUp Mac** allows you to uninstall an App from the **Applications** folder of Mac OS.

To uninstall applications directly from Applications tab, follow the steps given below:

- 1. Run SpeedUp Mac.
- 2. On the main screen, click SpeedUp Now icon.
- 3. Now the Uninstaller icon is present on all the screens.
- 4. Click **Uninstaller**. You can see four tabs in the right pane. Click on **Applications** tab from the right pane. This will start the scanning of the **Applications** folder and display all apps from it.
- 5. Check the desired application and click **Search Associated Files** button. Extensive search finds all the supported files of the selected application.
- 6. Click Select All/Unselect All button to check/uncheck all the searched files.
- 7. Click Uninstall Now. A warning message is displayed.
- 8. Click **OK** button. "Uninstallation Complete" message is displayed.



If you want to exit the uninstaller section, click on **Close** Webutton.

Widgets

You can use Widgets tab to uninstall the widgets stored in the widgets folder of Mac OS. To uninstall Widgets, follow the steps given below:

- 1. Run SpeedUp Mac.
- 2. On the main screen, click **SpeedUp Now** icon.
- 3. Now the **Uninstaller** icon is present on all the screens.
- 4. Click **Uninstaller**. You can see four tabs in the right pane. Click on **Widgets** tab from the right pane. This will start scanning for widgets installed in Mac OS and will display them.
- 5. Select the desired **Widgets** or click **Select All/Unselect All** button to check/uncheck all the widgets.
- 6. Click **Uninstall Now**. A warning message is displayed.
- 7. Click OK button. "Uninstallation Complete" message is displayed.





Plug-ins

SpeedUp Mac helps in removing plug-ins from the system.

To uninstall Plug-ins, follow the steps given below:

- 1. Run SpeedUp Mac.
- 2. On the main screen, click **SpeedUp Now** icon.
- 3. Now the Uninstaller icon is present on all the screens.
- 4. Click **Uninstaller**. You can see four tabs in the right pane. Click on **Plug-ins** tab from the right pane. This will start scanning for Plug-ins installed in Mac OS and will display them.
- 5. Select the desired **Plug-ins** or click **Select All/Unselect All** button to check/uncheck all the plugins.
- 6. Click **Uninstall Now**. A warning message is displayed.
- 7. Click OK button. "Uninstallation Complete" message is displayed.

Set SpeedUp Mac Preferences

Preferences can be set to run SpeedUp Mac according to personal requirement.

To set the preferences follow these steps.

- 1. Run SpeedUp Mac.
- 2. Click **SpeedUp Mac** in the toolbar. Click **Preferences** option in the menu.
- 3. To change General preferences, click General tab.
- 4. To change Folder search preferences, click **Folder Search** tab.
- 5. To change Language files preferences, click Languages tab.
- 6. To Apply filter preferences, click **Files** tab.
- 7. To change Removable memory devices cleanup preferences, click Devices tab.
- 8. To change Advanced preferences, click **Advanced** tab.
- 9. To change Scheduler preferences, click **Scheduler** tab.
- 10. To change Ignore List preferences, click Ignore List tab.

General

In **General** preferences, you can specify the files that should be searched by the **SpeedUp Mac** during scan. These files are not used, unnecessarily acquire memory and slow down the system. Separate general preferences are set for **SpeedUp Now** activities in the application.

To apply General preferences,

- 1. Run SpeedUp Mac.
- 2. Click SpeedUp Mac in the menu bar. Click Preferences option in the menu.

General Preferences

- 3. Click General tab.
- 4. To set general preferences for Recommended Scan, in SpeedUp Now section:
 - Check / Uncheck options available in Caches.
 - Check / Uncheck options available in Logs.
 - Check / Uncheck options available in Files.
- 5. To set general preferences for Custom Scan, check / uncheck options available in Files option.
- 6. Click **OK** to save **Preferences** settings.

Folder Search

Folders that will be scanned during scanning process can be specified in the application. This reduces the time required in the search operation. **SpeedUp Mac** provides **Folder Search** preferences to specify the folders that will be scanned to find universal binaries and language resources files. You can specify different folders for **SpeedUp Now** activities.

To apply Folder Search preferences,



Folder Search Options

- 1. Run SpeedUp Mac.
- Select Preferences option from SpeedUp Mac menu.
- 3. Click Folder Search tab.
- To specify folders to be searched for SpeedUp Now process,
 - For universal binaries files: Click
 [+]/[-] in the Folder to be searched for Universal binaries list to add/remove folders.
 - For Language resources files: Click [+]/[-] in the Folder to be searched for language Resources list to add/remove folders.

If no folder is specified, selected Volume will be scanned.

6. Click **OK** to save **Preferences** settings.

Languages

SpeedUp Mac provides an advanced **Languages** option for searching language files. Various languages in alphabetical order are shown. You can check the desired languages from the list for scanning. The scan will find all the applications with selected languages. From the scan result you can remove the applications along with the language files. To delete these language files, preferences can be set in **SpeedUp Mac**.

To apply language files preferences:

Languages Preferences

- 1. Run SpeedUp Mac.
- Click SpeedUp Mac in the menu bar. Click Preferences option in the menu.
- 3. Click Languages tab. A list of language files is shown.
- Under the Select Language files to scan for frame, check the language files that are to be removed.
- You can set style to view scan result as group by software and group by language.
- 6. Click **OK** to save the preferences.

Make sure that you have checked only the **unnecessary** language files.

Files

An advanced Files Filter Settings option is provided to set filter, i.e. to include or exclude desired file types while removing unwanted files. For example, if you want to search all files except the graphic files, you need to add graphic file type to the filter list and click 'Scan excluding these files'. The scan result will not show these excluded graphic files. Filter allows you to select files on the basis of extensions. You can include, exclude files by applying filter in case of large files and duplicate files.

Filter settings option also allows you to specify file size or period of time the files has not been accessed. You can change the parameters as per your requirement. If you check the option 'Remember these values for all sessions', then the specified settings will be applied whenever you run the process. While searching for large files, you can specify both parameters - file size and period of time the file has not been used, but for duplicate files only files size can be specified.

To apply Filter preferences,

- 1. Run SpeedUp Mac.
- 2. Click SpeedUp Mac in the menu bar. Click Preferences option in the menu.
- 3. Click Files tab.
- 4. To apply filter for large files, click **Large Files** tab. By default, this tab is active. A list of extensions categorized according to file types is available in drop-down box.
- 5. Select a group from Enter Filter Basis listbox.



Filter Options for Large Files

6. Click [+] button. All extensions under that group will be listed in the box.

- You can also add a file extension other than the available extensions. Clear the selected items in the listbox and then type the extension prefixed by *. (for example *.txt) in the Enter File Basis listbox. Click [+] button.
- 8. To remove any file extension from the list, select it and click [-] button. Files that are having the same extension will not be included while scanning.
- 9. Select Scan for these files only to scan the files with listed file extensions.
- 10. Select Scan excluding these files to exclude files with listed file extensions from scanning.
- 11. In the right pane of application, specify size in **Find large file(s) with size greater than** box. Scanning will be done for files greater than the specified size.
- 12. Specify number of **day/month/year** in **Find Large file(s) not accessed in last** box. Large file not accessed during specified number of **day/month/year** will be included in scanning.
- 13. To apply filter for duplicate files, click Duplicate Files tab. Repeat Steps 5 10. In the right pane of application, specify size in Find Duplicate file(s) with size greater than box. Scanning will be done for files greater than the specified size.

Filter Options for Duplicate Files

- 14. Select scan type option, that is, either Quick scan or Strict scan to scan for duplicate files.
- 15. Select **Do not scan Applications** checkbox if you do not want to scan applications.
- 16. Click **OK** to save preferences.



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After the filter is applied, you can click **Preferences** option and click **Remove File Filter** under **Files** tab to remove an already existing filter.


When all files (including large and duplicate files) are selected for cleanup, File Cleanup Options screen (as shown above) is displayed. Choose from the available options and click **Proceed**.

Devices

Removable storage devices may have junk files stored in them. These files can be deleted to clean the devices at the time they are plugged into the system. SpeedUp Mac gives Devices preferences option that can be saved to clean the device at the time of its attachment.

To set preferences for devices:



Devices Preferences

- 1. Run SpeedUp Mac.
- Click SpeedUp Mac in the menu bar. Click Preferences option in the menu.
- 3. Click Devices tab.
- Check Enable automatic trash cleanup option to delete .Trashes folder from external storage device automatically.
- Check Enable automatic Mac OS service junk cleanup option to delete the junk files created by Mac OS. .DS_Store files and Spotlight-V100 folders are deleted.
- 6. Check Enable automatic Windows service junk cleanup option to delete *Thumbs.db* file and *RECYCLED* folder.
- 7. Click **OK** to save **Preferences** settings.

Advanced Settings

SpeedUp Mac provides advanced settings for sound on event, automatic uninstaller, and trash monitor. **Automatic Uninstaller** feature provided by **SpeedUp Mac** will launch **SpeedUp Mac** and pop up a message whenever you drag an application to trash folder.

To set advanced settings:



Advance Settings Preferences

- 1. Run SpeedUp Mac.
- Click SpeedUp Mac in the menu bar. Click Preferences option in the menu.
- 3. Click Advanced tab.
- To assign a sound to be played at the end of process, select Play Sounds option. Click Browse button to select a saved sound file.
- 5. Select Enable Automatic

Uninstaller option to remove all the files of an application when the application is dragged to **Trash** folder.

- Select Enable Trash Status Monitor option to limit total size of all files in Trash.
- Check Do not ask before emptying trash check box to

automatically clear trash when the total size of files in trash exceeds the specified limit.

8. Click **OK** to save the **Preferences** settings.

Scheduler

Scheduler preferences allows to schedule update and tasks that will be automatically executed on a preset time and date. **Scheduler** supports settings for updating and launching **SpeedUp Mac**. To run the Scheduler,

1. Run SpeedUp Mac.

- 2. Click **SpeedUp Mac** in the menu bar. Click **Preferences** option in the menu.
- 3. Click Scheduler tab.
- 4. To set schedule update task preferences,
 - Select Check for updates option to receive latest updates at startup at specified interval.
 - Choose interval (Daily, Weekly or Monthly).
 - Click to **Check for updates now** button to start update wizard. This wizard automatically detects new updates available for the software and download available updates.

- 5. To set time preferences to automatically launch the application,
 - Select Launch SpeedUp Mac automatically option.

- Application gives various range of option to set frequency and time setting. Application will run
 according to set preferences. Select frequency (Daily, Weekly or Monthly) and time at which
 the application will get launched automatically.
- 6. Click **OK** to save **Preferences** settings.

Ignore List

Ignore List contains a list of applications whose universal binary files will not be included in the scan operation of **SpeedUp Mac**. You can add new applications in the default list. The added application can be removed later from the list but no application can be removed from the default list supplied by the application.

To add new application in the 'Excluded Applications' list

- 1. Run SpeedUp Mac.
- 2. Click SpeedUp Mac in the menu bar. Click Preferences option in the menu.
- 3. Click **Ignore List** tab.
- 4. Click on [+] icon located at the right-bottom of the list.
- 5. Applications folder will be opened. Select the required application and click **Open** button.
- 6. Click OK button.



Preferences for Ignore List

To remove added application from the 'Excluded Applications' list:

- 1. Run SpeedUp Mac.
- 2. Click **SpeedUp Mac** in the toolbar. Click **Preferences** option in the menu.
- 3. Click Ignore List tab.
- 4. Select the application in the Excluded Applications list.

- 5. Click on [-] icon located at the right-bottom of the list.
- 6. Click **OK** button.



If you try to add an application that is already present in the **Ignore List**, it will be shown in the list as selected and will not get added.

FAQs

1. How SpeedUp Mac can be useful for a Mac user?

Main purpose of **SpeedUp Mac** is to enhance the Mac hard drive performance by removing unwanted files. At the same time, by removing unnecessary files, lots of drive space is created that again helps in improving the speed of your system.

2. How can I restore language files if I've accidentally removed them?

If you have accidentally deleted language files that you need, you can get them back only by reinstalling Mac OS X. Or, if these language files belong to any application, you can get them back only by reinstalling that application.

3. When I dragged an application into trash, a message popped up. Why?

SpeedUp Mac provides an advanced feature **Automatic Uninstaller**, which helps you to uninstall the application. By default, **Enable Automatic Uninstaller** option is **ON**. That is, whenever you drag an application into the trash, **SpeedUp Mac Uninstaller** will be launched popping up a message. This allows you to uninstall the application, instead of deleting it. To disable the option, launch **SpeedUp Mac** and click **Uninstaller Settings**. Uncheck the checkbox and click **OK**.

4. I have downloaded SpeedUp Mac, want to activate it. How?

To activate SpeedUp Mac, you need to order and purchase it. Once you purchase the product, you will receive the activation key through email. Use this key to activate the product. Please follow the steps mentioned below to activate using activation key:

- 1. Click **Register** in **Tools** menu.
- 2. In the registration window that pops up, select '*I have a key to register the product*'. Click **OK**.
- 3. Enter the Registration key and click **OK**, to complete the activation process.

Alternatively, when you try to Uninstall any application or remove any Large, Duplicate, Universal, Cache or Languages files using demo version, SpeedUp Mac Registration window pops up. Follow the steps mentioned above to activate.

5. One of the volumes in my secondary hard drive is showing full. Is it possible to remove unwanted files from the volume using SpeedUp Mac and how?

Yes, it is possible using **SpeedUp Mac**. **Custom Scan** feature in SpeedUp Mac will enable you to select specific volume, even from secondary hard drive, and removes all unnecessary files.

6. When I click on the SpeedUp Mac shortcut in docks, the software is not launched. A '?' symbol is shown instead. What could be the problem?

It may that you have uninstalled the application and the shortcut is not removed after Uninstallation.

7. How to set preferences for language files in SpeedUp Mac?

To apply language files preferences, follow these steps.

- a. Run SpeedUp Mac.
- b. Click **SpeedUp Mac** in the toolbar. Click **Preferences** option in the menu.
- c. Click Languages tab. A list of language files is shown.
- d. Under the **Select Language files to scan for** frame, check the language files that are to be removed.
- e. You can set style to view scan result as group by software and group by language.
- 6. Click OK to save the preferences.

8. What are login items and why should i remove them?

Login items can be a frequently used application, document, server's Internet Location file, or other items which auto-start at boot time and open automatically when you log in to your Mac. This increases the booting time of your system.

In order to decrease the booting time of your Mac and enhance its performance, it is advised that you remove them.

9. What kind of unwanted and unused files that are scanned by SpeedUp Mac for freeing up space from a volume?

SpeedUp Mac scans for the following kinds of files for freeing up space from a volume:

Cache Files - consists of temporary files created by an application installer to load and work faster. There are different types of caches (for example - User Caches , iOS Caches and System Caches) in the system. **Log Files** - contains information about device changes, device drivers, system changes, events, operations and more. There are different types of logs such as User Logs and System Logs which you can find in the system.

System Junk - consists of all the junk includes universal binaries, language files and other junk files from the applications in the system.

Trashes & Leftovers - are all files and leftovers which are present in the Trash.

Manage Extensions - consists of various extension files and preferences that you do not need on your Mac.

Universal Binaries - are executable files or application bundles that run natively on Mac computers.

Language Files - are localization files for OS X applications. It typically contains the .nib files for a given language. A software application supports different languages.

Duplicate Files - are copies of existing files.

Large Files - Large file size is set at 100 MB for the application by default.
